Are you a Landed Immigrant or Convention Refugee?

We can help:

Identify your settlement needs to determine how to address them.

Provide you with information on life in Canada and the community such as education, health, social services, housing, banking, legal matters.. etc

Connect you to other community resources/services (cultural, educational, recreational and other service providers).

Advocate and place phone calls for you when dealing with day-to-day issues.

If you have a problem adjusting to life in Canada, or have a personal problem, we will link you up with specialized counselling services.

Accompany you to other service providers, if needed.

Provide Specific Sessions on topics relevant to your settlement needs.

Provide Job Search Workshops (JSW) that focus on skills identification, resume and cover letter writing, interview practices and job search techniques. (Childcare provided for participants).

Offer basic computer training that will assist you with employment readiness.

Through Library Settlement Partnerships (LSP), our Settlement Worker at Jalna Branch Library provides information and referral to immigrants and refugees to access library services/programs and other community resources.

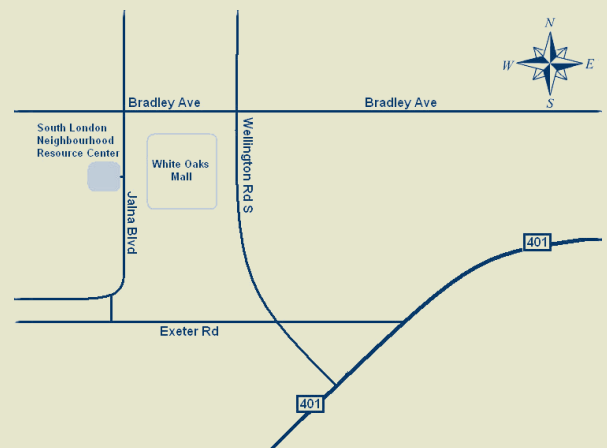
