**Integration Leader – Summer Sunsation**

**Position overview:** "Summer Sunsation" is a day camp for youth ages 11-14 years in the South London area, taking place at South London Neighbourhood Resource Centre.

The Integration Leader will begin by preparing Summer Sunsation, then facilitating the day camp. This position will be responsible for ensuring that all daily activities are inclusive for all youth. This is an 8-week position, June-August 2019.

**Responsibilities:**

- Ensure that all programming is inclusive, and all youth feel welcome and supported. Many of our youth participants who attend face numerous barriers (newcomer to Canada, language, intellectual disability, behaviour, being in Foster Care, low-income).
- Help to facilitate the daily activities of the summer camp
- Help with the planning and organizing of daily activities
- Support Coordinator and Assistant Coordinator with promotion of Summer Sunsation
- Assist with the organizing of various special activities including weekly outings and trips
- Act as a role model to the youth that attend the program, leading by positive example
- Act as mediator when conflict arises and handle problems fairly
- Attend weekly staff meetings organized by the Coordinator
- Motivate and encourage youth to engage in activities
- Set-up before and clean-up after each activity and at the end of each day
- Report to the Coordinator
- Abide by the policies and procedures of the South London Neighbourhood Resource Centre

**Qualifications:**

- **Must be returning to school in fall of 2018 full-time**
- **Need to provide a current Police Criminal Record Check**
- **Interest and experiences working with youth facing barriers to integration**
- Post-Secondary Education in the Human Services Field (SSW, CYW, Recreation, Sociology, etc.)
- Responsible, trustworthy and approachable
- Have the ability to connect with youth and get them involved positively
- Patient and understanding towards various cultures/ abilities
- Understanding of boundaries between your role and the participants
- **First Aid and CPR certified**
