Youth Leader

Professional Qualifications: Post-Secondary education in a field related to Human Services; plus 2 years actively working with youth. Youth supervisory role is mandatory.

Commitment: 17 hours a week. September – March 27, 2020.

Duties: The Youth Leader will be responsible for assisting the Manager of Youth Services in running of the South London Youth Centre and organizing programs such as Youth Centre Council, Tutoring, Youth Nutrition Programs, and more. The Youth Leader will also be responsible for the recruitment, training and support of youth volunteers at SLNRC.

Responsibilities:

- Work directly with and advocate for youth through various after school programs.
- Supervise and support placement students during the day-to-day programs, and special events
- Promote awareness and support for youth activities and youth volunteer opportunities.
- Provide creative program development that would be beneficial to youth in afterschool programs.
- Develop a volunteer recruitment, training and support system that will engage local youth.
- Maintain up-to-date program reporting and program evaluation for all youth programs
- Lead the South London Youth Centre Council in biweekly meeting and special events.
- Create nutrition programs and activities that teach youth healthy eating, physical activities and life skills.
- Offer seasonal resume writing and employment readiness training.

Qualifications:

- Post Secondary Education in the Human Services field (Social Service Worker, Child and Youth Worker, BSW, MSW or equivalent)
- Experience working with youth (11-24 years)
- Ability to work with a diverse population
- Strong communication and organizational skills
- Highly motivated, creative thinker and a self starter
- Ability to work independently as well as the ability to lead a team of youth workers
- Supervisory experience a must
- Ability to assist with writing of grants and liaising with funders as needed
